### Old Business

1. *Sponsoring Residents for Bridge Run* – DHHC sponsors up to \$250 for the first few runners. Could we give away 15 shirts for people to wear at the Bridge Run instead? Good idea, have a sign up sheet in the office to give the first 15 people to get MHA shirts.
2. *Budget Approval-* We need to approve the budget. \$2,548 is the run over from last year. Tucker Inn makes a motion to approve the budget, and Toll House I seconds the motion. Motion passes with total consensus.

### New Business

1. *Fall Ball Allocations* – \$700 should be allocated for the Fall Ball; \$30 for food, \$400 for SLS and the rest for random stuff, like decorations. The fall ball is the biggest fall semester event that MHA puts on. Toll House I motions to approve \$700 for the fall ball, Tucker Inn seconds the motion. All vote to pass the motion.
